

Well-Child Assessment

- Consultation with a Specialist Paediatrician.
- Review of personal and family medical history.
- Review of immunisation status.
- Complete physical examination.
- Hearing Test.
- Eye test:
 - Near, distant and colour vision
 - Phorias (Squint detection)
- Radiological Studies:
 - X-ray of the chest (heart and lungs)
- Blood Tests:
 - Haemoglobin
 - Red cell count
 - WCC & Differential
 - Haematocrit
 - Indices
 - Platelets
- Tests for Serum Iron and G-6-PD Deficiency.
- Urinalysis:
 - pH
 - Bilirubin
 - Albumin
 - Culture & Sensitivity
 - Sugar
 - Ketones
 - Microscopy
- Stool Examination:
 - Pus cells
 - Cysts & Ova (Parasites)
 - Red cells
 - Culture and Sensitivity
- Written report of examination findings and recommendations.
